At the 2008 ICD National Conference, five **\$1000** scholarships will be awarded to various children/grandchildren of steelworkers.

The *Tino Fulimeni Scholarship Fund* was established to honor the memory of Brother Fulimeni. Tino was a fanatic about ICD. His commitment and contribution are evident in the success of the Career Development Program.

The *Fund* is administered by ICD in Merrillville, IN.

The following criteria must be met to be eligible for the scholarship drawing:

- ❖ Applicant must be a high school graduate enrolled in college and beginning in the fall semester of 2008 or the spring semester of 2009 *or* a college student returning to school in the fall semester of 2008 or spring semester of 2009.
- ❖ Applicant must have maintained, in the past, at least a cumulative 3.0 grade point average and can demonstrate this with a transcript if selected.
- ❖ Applicant must be the child/grandchild of a steelworker who is currently eligible to participate in the Career Development Program.

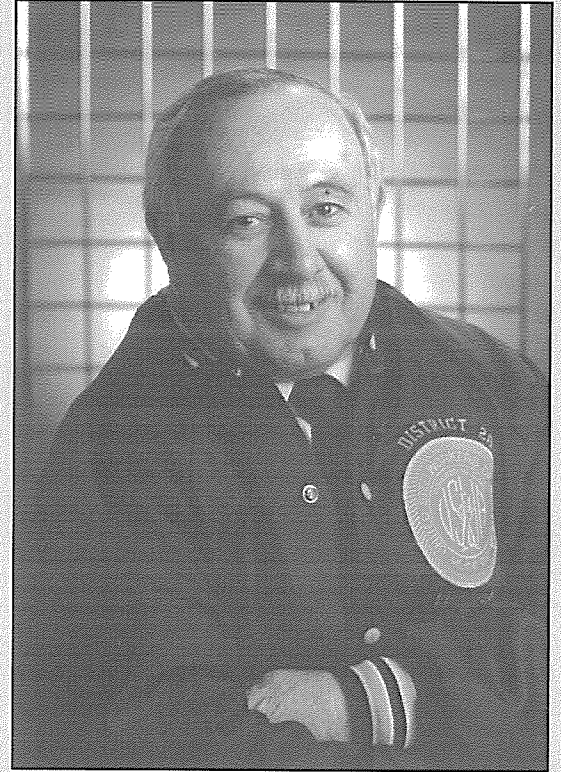
